Prizes for Medley and Men's Competitions January 2022

The current competition entry fee is \$17.50 for 18-hole events and \$15.00 for 9-hole events.

General Prizes

1. 18-hole event, the prize money awards are :
 - Individual or team winner per player \$60
 - Individual or team runner up per player \$30
 - In single events, when the fields exceed 70 (Wednesday) or 90 (Saturday) a runner-up prize will be paid to each of the grade winners on the day \$30

2. 9-hole event, for all non-medal events the prize money awards are :
 - 1st individual \$45
 - 2nd Individual \$30
 - 3rd Individual \$25
 - 4th Individual \$20
 - Individual or team winner per player \$45
 - Individual or team runner up per player \$30
 - Ball Rundown commences from the 5th placed finisher.

Player numbers

Prize Allocations according to player numbers

Single 18-hole Events

1. 2-3 Players winner \$30
2. 4-6 Players winner \$30 + 2 balls
3. 7-10 Players Winner \$60 + 4 Balls
4. Events of 10 Players or less, ball rundown starts at 2nd place.
5. Events 11 Players and above, Winner \$60, R/up \$30 and Ball Rundown as per schedule.
6. Events of 80 + players Overall winner \$60 and \$30 for each grade winner, any day.

4BBB Events

1. Must be a minimum of 12 players, or the event reverts to a Singles event.
2. 12-17 players Winners \$60 each + normal Ball Rundown.
3. 18 Players + as per normal General Prize schedule.

Team Events of 3 or 4 Players

1. Must be a minimum of 20 players, or the event reverts to a single event.
2. 20-28 players, winners \$60 each + normal Ball Rundown.

9-hole Event

1. Minimum 8 players for full prize rundown of General Prizes and Ball Rundown schedule.
2. 7 players winner + R/up + 2 Balls.
3. 6 Players Winner + R/up + 1 Ball.
4. 5 Players Winner only + 2 Balls
5. 4 Players Winner only + 1 Ball.
6. 2-3 Players Winner only @ \$30.

Medal round

The once per month medal round shall be played as a stroke round only, as is the case at most other clubs.

The awards are

- 1st in Grade (eligible players only) ----- \$60 + medal
- 2nd in Grade ----- \$30.
- Best gross score (any entered player in comp all grades) ----- \$30.

Trophy Events

In a Trophy event, the best placed eligible score (single or team) will win the trophy. The Trophy is engraved with the winner's name and includes a \$60 voucher. Where the Trophy is for a Club Championship, the winner/winners receive two vouchers each to the Presentation Dinner, whilst the runners up receive one voucher each to the dinner.

Note : If the trophy winner returns the best score for the day's competition, they will also win the applicable general prize.

Ball Rundown

The ball rundown for all competitions with the exception of the “9 hole Nugget” is as follows: (The “Nugget” ball rundown commences at the 5th placed finisher).

- 0 to 10 players ----- 3 balls
- 11 to 20 players ----- 3 plus 2
- 21 to 30 players ----- 6 plus 2
- 31 to 40 players ----- 9 plus 2
- 41 to 50 players ----- 12 plus 2
- 51 to 60 players ----- 15 plus 2
- 61 to 70 players ----- 18 plus 2
- 71 to 80 players ----- 21 plus 2
- 81 to 90 players ----- 24 plus 2
- 91 to 100 players ----- 27 plus 2
- 101 to 110 players ----- 30 plus 2

Countbacks

Should more than one player (or team) return a score equal to another a countback will be processed in the following manner. (Golf Australia guidelines)

Stroke events

For all events where a stroke score is recorded the nett scores shall be compared firstly over the last 9 holes, then the last 6 holes, then the last 3 holes, then hole by hole from 18 backwards. The players/teams handicap will be prorated across the number of holes assessed.

Stableford events.

Stableford events will be assessed as for a stroke event except that the stableford points will be assessed instead of the nett score.
