JOHN OWENS MEMORIAL TROPHY FOUR-BALL KNOCKOUT

The John Owen Memorial Trophy is in memory of Mr John A Owens AO. The Silver Tray was donated to the Club in 1995 as part of a bequest from his estate that also provided for the Camellias behind the 8th Tee, the seat at the 18th Green and Course improvements. The first winners of the John Owen Memorial Trophy were Ross Barter and Brian Lamb.

TERMS OF COMPETITION

1. The Four-Ball Match Play Knockout is open to Eligible Members (i.e., Male; Full Playing, Honorary Life, Visiting, City, Intermediate, Junior Playing) of Bowral Golf Club and will be match play in accordance with the Rules of Golf and the Local Rules of Bowral Golf Club.
2. The Closing date for entries is listed on the on-line calendar.
3. A standard competition entry fee per player must be paid to the pro-shop before the Entries Close Date otherwise the players will not be included in the draw.
4. Players will play off Club handicaps (maximum 36) applicable on the day of play. The lowest marker will allow his partner and opponents strokes equivalent to the difference in their handicaps. Strokes will be taken in accordance with the match play index on the foot of the scorecard. Play is off the Blue plates.
5. Knockout matches must not be played in conjunction with any other Club competition. (Rule 33-1)
6. The dates for completion of matches and finals are set out in the On-line Calendar.
7. Matches will be played on the designated Sunday as indicated in the club Calendar. Tee times will be established by the pro shop, and teams need to arrive in time for play. If a team wishes to play their match at a date earlier than the designated Sunday, they may do so by arranging a suitable time with the opposing team. There is no obligation for any team to play their match on a day other than the designated Sunday. Except in exceptional circumstances, no extension beyond the closing date will be permitted.
N.B. Should a team not be able to complete their match on or by the designated date, that team will forfeit. Where no result is recorded by the closing date, both teams will be disqualified.
8. All matches will start at the first hole. If the match is all-square at the end of 18 holes, play will continue until a decision is reached. If play is temporarily suspended for any reason e.g. darkness, course unfit for play, it shall be resumed from where it was discontinued even though resumption occurs on a subsequent day. The result of the match is to be recorded on the draw on the Club notice board by either the winning or losing team, at the conclusion of the match. The Club Captain will nominate a referee and match tee time for the final, which will be played over 18 holes.
9. The winners will have their names inscribed on the John Owen Memorial Trophy and each will receive a voucher for a team winners award. The runners-up will each receive a voucher for a team runner-up award.
