## **CLUB MIXED FOURSOMES HANDICAP for the Wotton Trophy**

### **History**

The Club Mixed Foursomes Championship was first played in 1980 with winners recorded on the Honour Board. The first winners were P K Douglas and Mrs D Missingham.

The Club Mixed Foursomes Handicap originated in 1993 with the winners awarded the Wotton Trophy which had been donated by Mr and Mrs R K Wotton. The first winners were P K Douglas and Mrs D Missingham.

### **Terms of the Competition**

The Club Mixed Foursomes Championship and Mixed Foursomes Handicap are limited to Eligible Members (i.e. Mixed, Full Playing Members, Honorary Life Members, Women's Golf Members, Visiting Members, City Members, Intermediate Members, Junior Playing Members) of Bowral Golf Club. Both events will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf and the Local Rules of Bowral Golf Club Limited. One standard competition entry fee will cover both events.

### **Club Mixed Foursomes Championship**

The Mixed Foursomes Championship is a scratch stroke event, over 2 rounds of 18 holes on the day published in the on-line calendar. As this competition is a Club Championship the Blue Course will be played. The order of play for the 2nd round will be a seeded draw determined from the results of the 1st round.

- Tee off order.
  - o Round 1: The women will play off the first tee and play the team's tee shots for each odd numbered hole.
  - o Round 2: The men will tee off the first tee and play the team's tee shot for each odd numbered hole.
  
- Tied Scores.
  - o In the event of a tie after round 2, a playoff will commence after all the field have completed their rounds.
  - o The playoff will be over four holes; holes 1, 2, 3 and 18.
  - o If there is no result, then a "sudden death" playoff on these holes until a result is reached.

### **Club Mixed Foursomes Handicap – Wotton’s Trophy**

The Mixed Foursomes Handicap is a handicap stroke event, played in conjunction with the two rounds of the Club Mixed Foursomes Championship.

- Handicaps. Players will play using their current AGU daily handicap each day of competition. All teams must have a marker for each round.
  
- Tee off order.
  - o Round 1: The women will play off the first tee and play the team’s tee shots for each odd numbered hole.
  - o Round 2: The men will tee off the first tee and play the team’s tee shot for each odd numbered hole.
  
- Tied Scores.
  - o In the event of a tie after Round 2, the winners will be determined by Scorecard Count-back based on the round 2 scorecard as per the R&A Committee Procedures 5A.6.

The names of the winners of the Mixed Foursomes Championship will be inscribed on the Club Foursomes Championship Honour Board. The winners will each receive a voucher for entry and complimentary food for two at the Club’s Annual Anniversary Dinner. The runners-up will each receive a voucher for entry and complimentary food for one at the Club’s Annual Anniversary Dinner.

The names of the winners of the Mixed Foursomes Handicap will be engraved on the Wotton’s Trophy. The winners and runners-up each receive a standard team prize voucher.
